

Arbitration Advocacy Training

The Office of Collective Bargaining, along with SERB and the state's union partners, OCSEA, SEIU/1199, OEA, FOP, and OSTA will offer a one day training program on **Arbitration Advocacy** on April 1, 2010. The program will feature presentations by six professional labor arbitrators who will address various issues related to the role of an advocate in an arbitration hearing. These detailed presentations will provide a good foundation for someone that is currently working as an arbitration advocate or who has an interest in doing so.

- The intended audience for this program is advocates for full panel arbitration. (Mediation and Non-Traditional Arbitration training will be offered at a later date.)
