MARCS Steering Committee meets Nov. 5

The Ohio Multi-Agency Radio Communications System (MARCS) Steering Committee will meet from 8:30 to 10:30 a.m. Friday, Nov. 5 at the headquarters of the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction, 770 W. Broad St., Columbus.

Agenda items include a review of the standup of the next generation of MARCS in Cuyahoga and Lake counties, an update regarding the recommendations in the report produced by the MARCS Task Force and a review of the proposed development of eight tower sites.

MARCS is the State of Ohio's comprehensive wireless communication system for police, fire, emergency medical services and other public safety forces. MARCS provides wireless voice and mobile data for state agencies, including the Ohio departments of Natural Resources, Public Safety, and Rehabilitation and Correction. MARCS also provides wireless voice radio service for nearly 1,300 county, township, federal and private first-responders.
