All items must be removed by 5 p.m. the day of the sale. Purchases must be loaded by the buyer. No personnel will be available to help load items. No items will be sold prior to the sale.

This sale is being held by the Ohio Department of Administrative Services' State and Federal Surplus Services on behalf of the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities to provide the general public an opportunity to purchase quality goods at reduced prices and enable the state to recoup a portion of its initial investment.
