

Input Form 29 – Monthly Utilization Work Hour Report

The contracting agency's EEO Compliance Officer shall review the Input Form 29 (I-29) reports to determine the following:

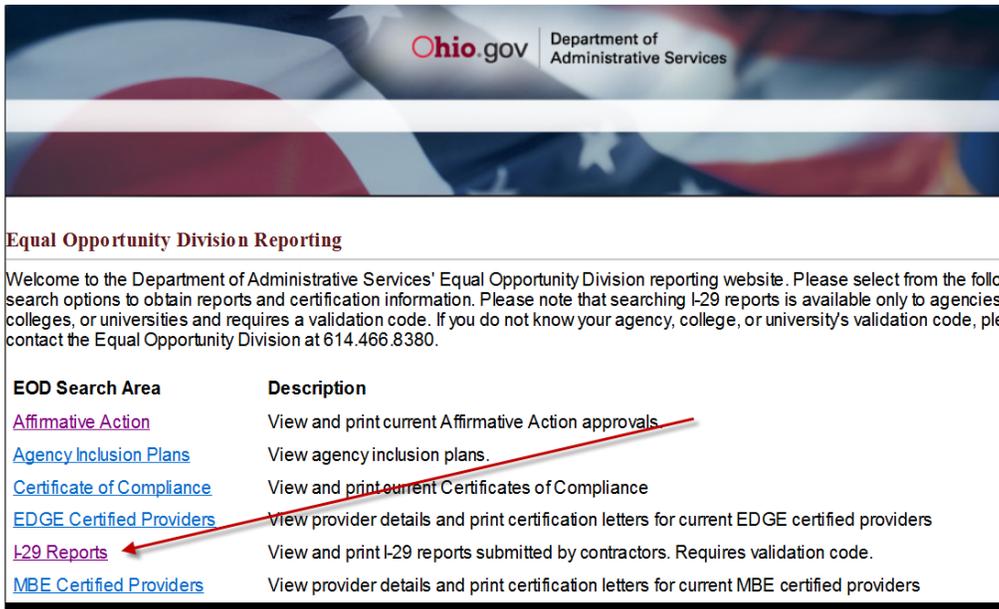
- Contractors and subcontractors submit reports monthly while performing on the agency's locally administered construction projects; and
- Contractors and subcontractors comply with the equal employment opportunity and affirmative action requirements. The contractor's compliance shall be based on the company's documented good faith efforts to accomplish the minority and women utilization goals outlined in either the State of Ohio's affirmative action program (AAP) or the contractor's approved AAP.

Accessing I-29s

The Equal Opportunity Division (EOD) of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services (DAS) provides contracting agencies access to view the I-29 reports. Each agency is assigned a validation code to view the I-29s.

Instructions to access I-29s
