User ID Audit: In an effort to ensure that only active User IDs remain in FleetOhio, the Office of Fleet Management (OFM) recently sent reports to each agency listing all of the User IDs for each. It was requested that the list would be reviewed, those User IDs that are no longer necessary identified on the report, and the updated report returned to the Office of Fleet Management. To date, we have received responses from about half of the agencies. If you have not yet reviewed/responded, please do so as soon as possible. The Office of Fleet Management will review the reports and disable those User IDs that are determined to be inactive.
