Project Overview

A. Project Description

The State Architect's Office (SAO) intends to pre-qualify firms to provide architectural and landscape architectural services for projects that are not advertised through the Ohio Register. In order for any firm on the FY10-FY11 list to be considered in the pre-qualification process for future projects, they must reapply.

This pre-qualification process will determine the list of firms that will be eligible for award of contracts for the period beginning July 1, 2011 and ending June 30, 2013. The current Consultant List expires on June 30, 2011.

Services are in support of the SAO design and management of projects, as well as to support state agency administration of projects. Consultants are generally utilized for small projects or specialized tasks in which the usual Ohio Register selection process would be cumbersome. All firms submitting a proposal in response to this RFQ will be eligible for consulting services opportunities.

Upon completion of the selection process, SAO will seek Controlling Board approval for total contract awards to each pre-qualified firm up to the amount of \$250,000 for the two-year period. Fees for each individual assignment will usually range in the amount of \$25,000 - \$75,000 per project. However, there may be exceptions where fees for an individual assignment will exceed \$75,000.

The number of pre-qualified architecture and landscape architecture consultants selected through this process is within the discretion of SAO. While pre-qualified status means that a firm is eligible for award of contracts, SAO does not guarantee that a firm will be awarded any work or make a representation of the amount of work a firm may receive within the two-year period.

B. Scope of Services

Work assignments may include: architectural, landscape architectural, and related specialty consulting services including but not limited to facility evaluation and master planning services; review or creation of a Program of Requirements; various studies; prototype building design; preparation of bidding and construction documents; pre-design investigations; quality assurance testing during construction; validation of existing site conditions; preparation of cost estimates; extensive pre-design investigations; code-required special inspection and testing; and quality assurance testing during construction.

Engineering and surveying services will be included in an upcoming Request for Qualifications specifically directed to all engineering disciplines.

Services will be provided in accordance with a standard form of consultant agreement. As a project is identified for architectural or landscape architectural services, SAO will notify a pre-qualified firm or firms of the project and provide a scope of work. Only the firm selected for an assignment will be requested to provide a fee proposal. The scope of work and schedule for a specific project will be described in an exhibit document attached to the agreement.

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SAO will initiate contract negotiations directed toward:

- (1) Ensuring that the firm and the agency have a mutual understanding of the essential requirements involved in providing the required services;
- (2) Determining that the firm will make available the necessary personnel, equipment, and facilities to perform the services within the required time; and
- (3) Agreeing upon fair and reasonable compensation, taking into account the estimated value, scope, complexity, and nature of the services.

Upon failure to negotiate a contract with an identified pre-qualified firm, SAO will inform the firm in writing of the termination of negotiations and enter into negotiations with another firm on the pre-qualified list.

Electronic submittals must be combined into one PDF file named with the project number listed on the RFQ and your firm's name. Use the "print" feature of Adobe Acrobat Professional or similar software for creating a PDF rather than using a scanner. If possible, please reduce the file size of the PDF. In Adobe Acrobat Professional, go to Advanced, then PDF Optimizer.

Below are the questions that have been received to date for the RFQ of the above-referenced project:

1. Is it possible to see a list of firms that were prequalified last round?
 - A. Please see the list of respondents approved by the Controlling Board for FY10-11 attached to the end of this document.
2. Is there a new form to be submitted?
 - A. Yes. Please use the current version of Form SAO-F110-330 (v0810) available on the SAO website at <http://ohio.gov/sao> (click on Forms).
3. How do we need to do for submitting our qualifications?
 - A. Please see Section H of the RFQ for detailed submittal instructions.
4. Is there a limitation on the number of projects that can be included in Section F (In other words, are we following the rule that only 10 architecture and landscape architecture projects – collectively – can be submitted)?
 - A. Yes, please list up to 10 projects, whether performed through the Consultant List or otherwise, relevant to various design services described in Section B, Scope of Services, of the RFQ.
5. Can we view our “scorecard” from our previous submittal in 2009?
 - A. You may contact Christina Ringley at christina.ringley@das.state.oh.us to make specific inquiries.
6. We’ve been pre-qualified in years past, but have never heard about any projects being awarded. If we are pre-qualified, should we regularly call into the State Architect’s office to check on upcoming potential project awards?
 - A. No, as stated in Section B, Scope of Services, on the RFQ: While pre-qualified status means that firm is eligible for award of contracts, SAO does not guarantee that a firm will be awarded any work or make representation of the amount of work a firm may receive within the two-year period.
7. Should we add consultants to our submittal, or are you looking for architects to submit by themselves? We have established good professional relationships with consultants who can offer landscape architecture or some of the other secondary services you list on the RFQ. We weren’t sure if you were looking for those folks to submit separately or if we should submit as a possible team. If we submit as a team, then of course we would only actually include the consultants that are applicable to any particular project scope that we would be providing a fee proposal for.

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- A. We are interested in the range of services provided by individual firms. The projects we will be using these consultants for are typically those for which SAO is the architect of record. We will assemble teams of consultants from the individual firms to perform the services required. Submit the full range of disciplines provided by the firm on a single statement of qualifications.
8. We have reviewed the above RFQ – DAS-11A999, and would like to verify that our current contract is still valid.
- A. The State Architect's Office is prequalifying firms for various services that will be required in the 2010-2011 biennium. The current Consultant List expires on June 30, 2011. In order for any firm on the current list to be considered in the pre-qualification process for future projects, they must reapply.
9. Do we need to submit again, as this RFQ is for a contract that will run from July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2013?
- A. Yes, your current eligibility expires on June 30, 2011.
10. Are all of the services listed under section D expected to be addressed in our submittal? In other words, we don't have "food service consulting" or "roofing consultant" in-house. Do we need to add members to our team to cover those services?
- A. See the answer to question 7 above.
11. Related to the above question, can you be more specific about what types of "specialty" services are required? Does our submittal necessarily have to address all of those services?
- A. We would like you to tell us about your firm. If you have internal specialists in any of the listed services, or specialties that are not listed, please include them in your statement of qualifications.
12. Regarding the services required, do you want only the submitting firms' qualifications (Architectural or Landscape Architecture) or should they also be inclusive of the secondary services listed? (e.g. Architectural as primary and Programming, food service, roofing, etc. as secondary)

13. I am submitting our F110-330 for the first time and would like to know if I need to list all the Engineers/Consultants we will be using with an Organizational Chart attached, given the fact that our consultants change with each RFQ.
- A. See the answer to question 7 above.
14. Also, I'm not sure how I can sign this document since you require that a pdf be sent instead of scanned files. Does it require a signature?
- A. For your electronic signature, simply type your name in the signature area of the statement of qualifications.
15. Are paper copies accepted?
- A. No. Any paper copies submitted will be discarded. Please see Section H of the RFQ for specific submittal instructions.

16. Page 3, Section H of the RFQ states 'Do not submit Page 2 of Section H (Commitment to Participate in the EDGE Business Assistance Program).' Page 2 is the 'Proposer Affirmation and Disclosure' form, not the EDGE form. Do we need to submit the 'Proposer Affirmation and Disclosure' form?

A Yes. There was a typographical error on the RFQ which has been corrected. You do not need to submit Page 3.

17. What were the scores of the top 20 firms in each discipline? Please provide the firm name and the score for each.

A You may contact Christina Ringley at christina.ringley@das.state.oh.us to make specific inquiries.

What contracts have been made with firms from the current consultant list? Please provide a list with firm name, discipline, project name, scope of work, and amount of contract. Please note which firms provided special consulting services such as facility evaluation, master planning, etc.

A You may contact Christina Ringley at christina.ringley@das.state.oh.us to make specific inquiries.

18. Can you clarify what building types these potential contracts cover? Examples include higher education, civic, office, healthcare, justice.

A Agencies served by the State Architect's Office include higher education, corrections, mental health and developmental disabilities. The projects may include a wide range of building types and unusual projects.

19. We submitted during the last go round, DAS-0090950. We received a letter saying that we were not shortlisted, and the actual short list showed that as well.

In the Q&A for the new submittal, DAS-11A999, we are listed as part of the prequalified list. We have recently been awarded a project, which I assume was based on our prequalification from this list. What was the purpose of the short list that was dated Feb. 3, 2009?

A. Firms that were short-listed and interviewed for the Architect or Engineer Pre-Qualified List (DAS-090950) are listed for pre-approval of consulting work for two fiscal years, effective July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2011. All other firms that submitted for the Architect or Engineer Pre-Qualified List (DAS-090950), were still listed as eligible for consultant contracts for the two year period with SAO reserving the right to request a technical proposal from any of them.

20. Our firm is not performing current consultant list projects. Under what specific criteria do you recommend identifying 10 projects?

A. Please list up to 10 projects, whether performed through the Consultant List or otherwise, relevant to various services described in Section B, Scope of Services, of the RFQ.

21. A significant number of points (10) are given to a firm by having completed a large number of State projects in the past. What can a firm with little State work performed in the past do to win projects?

A Services provided to any public authority following Ohio Revised Code Chapter 153 may be identified to meet 6.d. of the Consultant Selection Rating form (Knowledge of State of Ohio

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Capital Project Administration Process.) In the past, firms have teamed with firms that have state experience. The scoring for this selection is designed to provide opportunity for emerging firms (e.g. we are giving maximum points for three projects instead of five or more.)

What kind of information should we provide to show that the lead designer met the needs of the owner?

- A. Complete the resume form (Section E of the SAOF110-330 form) showing the range of projects designed.

What helps the reviewer determine if quality documents are developed?

- A. We are looking for the technical skills and experience of your staff for this item, including education, professional registration, and any credentials such as CDT, CCS, etc. that may apply.

Regarding budget & schedule management, what are the important things reviewers look for?

- A. Show us your estimates v. actual bids, and final cost; as well as original v. actual schedule with milestones and completion dates.

What information is needed to show the field rep has the ability to identify and solve issues?

- A. Complete the resume form (Section E of the SAOF110-330 form) describing previous projects, with challenges encountered and resolutions developed to demonstrate the ability to solve problems in the field.

22. As a start up Architectural firm we are responding to DAS-11A999 SAO Architect and Landscape Architect Consultant List RFQ for the first time. We anticipate becoming EDGE certified in June 2011 and desire to be recognized as such by SAO. Would you advise us to 1) respond to the subject RFQ listing ourselves as Edge certified pending 2) correspond with SAO June 2011 to notify of our revised Edge certified status 3) wait until next year's similar RFQ updating our Edge certified status at that time; or otherwise please so advise?

- A. Respond to the RFQ with your current EDGE status (certified or non-certified).

23. Your RFQ DAS-11A999 states that you are pre-qualifying "firms to provide architectural and landscape architectural services." When can we expect the RFQ for pre-qualifying Engineering Consultants?

- A. The Engineering and Surveying RFQ was published Nov. 10 with the deadline of Dec. 15, 2010.
