**I. PURPOSE:**

Delineate the Office of State Surplus' policy for handling vehicles that were sold at the public auction but not paid for or picked up.

**II. POLICY:**

Vehicles that were sold at the public auction but not paid for or picked up will be held and sold at the next public auction and/or made available to tax supported organizations for 60% of the NADA retail price. This policy is spelled out in **GSD-SFP-08**.

**III. PROCEDURES:**

Vehicles will no longer be offered to people who attended the auction at 80% of the selling price at the auction.
