



2015 Flexible Spending Accounts (FSA) Dependent Care Spending Account (DCSA) Worksheet

To help estimate your work-related dependent care expenses, use this sample worksheet to estimate the number of days your child(ren) will be in school or in the care of another individual. Please check your own school system schedule for accuracy, and estimate the days you will be on vacation and caring for your children yourself.

Be conservative in your estimates, since any money remaining in your account cannot be returned to you or carried forward to the next calendar year. Carryover does not apply to the Dependent Care Spending Account.
