Beginning in October 2014, employees and their dependents who are eligible for the *Take Charge! Live Well!* diabetes management program will have new points of contact for questions. (You will no longer contact Healthways for questions about your medication and supplies.)

The diabetes management program provides the highest level of diabetes self-management your health care benefit offers, including free coverage for insulin, certain testing supplies, and equipment.
