

Autism coverage available

State of Ohio employees and their dependents enrolled in the state's health plan are now able to receive treatment for Autism Spectrum Disorder. Coverage for both medical and behavioral health services is available for members medically diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder.



For medical coverage details:

- Scroll to the Plan Description section and click on **United Behavioral Health Plan Description**.

Receive up to \$350 in gift cards for participating in *Take Charge! Live Well!* – your health and wellness program. State employees and enrolled spouses can request a reward card from one of many national retailers after completing each of the following wellness activities:

- Biometric screening – Earn \$75;
 - Well-Being Assessment – Earn \$50;
 - Complete both of the above by Nov. 30 – Earn \$25;
 - Complete a Pathway – Earn \$200
 - Coaching Pathway: One-on-one telephonic coaching session;
- OR
- Online Pathway: Nine online tools and resources including exercise, nutrition and weight trackers.

You can request your reward card after you complete an activity throughout, or at the end of, the benefits year. If no reward card is elected by the end of the benefits year, a Visa reward card will be sent for the amount of all completed activities.
