

Pop-up Blocker may cause display difficulties when using Learn It Ohio's Skillsoft portal.

Have you had problem recently opening courses or books in Learn It Ohio? The cause may be a pop-up blocker.

Many advertisers on the Internet use pop-up windows to display their message in a way that is hard to miss. Internet Explorer Pop-up Blocker lets you prevent most pop-up windows from appearing over Web pages when you are browsing the Internet.

Note By default, Pop-up Blocker is enabled.

When logging in to Learn It Ohio make sure that Learn It Ohio is a trusted site and that the pop up blocker is off. Books24\7 will not open if the [terms and conditions](#) have been not acknowledged. This page will only appear if the pop up blocker is turned off. Once it is signed books 24\7 will open.

Pop-up Blocker limits or blocks pop-ups on sites that you visit. You can choose the level of blocking you prefer, turn on or off notifications when pop-ups are blocked, or create a list of sites that you don't want to block pop-ups on. Pop-up Blocker settings only apply to Microsoft Internet Explorer for the desktop.

Turn Pop-up Blocker on or off

1. Open Internet Explorer.
2. Click the **Tools**  button, and then click **Internet options**.
3. On the **Privacy** tab, under Pop-up Blocker, select or clear the **Turn on Pop-up Blocker** check box, and then click **OK**.

Block all pop-ups

Even if you turn pop-up blocker on, Internet Explorer won't block pop-ups from sites that are in the Local intranet or Trusted sites security zones. If you want to block all pop-ups—including pop-ups on Local intranet or Trusted sites—you'll have to change the blocking level. Here's how:

1. Open Internet Explorer.
2. Click the **Tools**  button, and then click **Internet options**.
3. On the **Privacy** tab, under Pop-up Blocker, click **Settings**.
4. In the Pop-up Blocker settings dialog box, set the blocking level to **High: Block all pop-ups (Ctrl + Alt to override)**.
5. Click **Close**, and then click **OK**.

Turn off notifications when pop-ups are blocked

You can turn off notifications if you don't want Internet Explorer to let you know every time it blocks a pop-up. Here's how:

1. Open Internet Explorer.
2. Click the **Tools**  button, and then click **Internet options**.
3. On the **Privacy** tab, under Pop-up Blocker, click **Settings**.
4. In the Pop-up Blocker settings dialog box, clear the **Show Notification bar when a pop-up is blocked** check box.
5. Click **Close**, and then click **OK**.

Change Pop-up Blocker settings

You choose to have pop-ups will appear only on the sites you want them to. Here's how:

1. Open Internet Explorer.
2. Click the **Tools**  button and then click **Internet options**.
3. Make any changes you would like, click **Close**, and then click **OK**.
