**JOB DUTIES IN ORDER OF IMPORTANCE:** (These duties are illustrative only. Incumbents may perform some or all of these duties or other job-related duties as assigned.)

Prepares surfaces for plastering to ensure that new plaster will adhere to surface & surrounding plaster, replaces broken metal or wooden lathes, chips out broken plaster & mixes plaster.

Applies plaster using standard or special tools & finishes off surfaces.

Prepares surfaces for painting & assists painter in painting, replaces & repairs broken ceiling & floor tiles.

**MAJOR WORKER CHARACTERISTICS:**

Knowledge of addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions & percentages; safety practices in plastering trade. Skill in plastering & use of plastering tools. Ability to carry out detailed but basic written or oral instructions; read short sentences with concrete vocabulary; stand, walk & bend continuously; lift up to 100 lbs. repeatedly; move limbs/fingers easily to perform manual functions repeatedly; move whole body in continuous or heavy labor.

**MINIMUM CLASS QUALIFICATIONS FOR EMPLOYMENT:**

Formal education in arithmetic that includes addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions & percentages & in reading & writing common English vocabulary; 12 mos. trg. or 12 mos. exp. in plastering under supervision of journey plasterer.
