Subject: Workforce Development Fund

The Office of Collective Bargaining has notified our office that the balance in AFSCME Workforce Development Fund has reached a level where additional contributions shall cease until further notice. This will become effective with the payroll period ending December 14, 2002. The charge was made to cover the costs associated with article 37.02 of the OCSEA agreement.

Employees represented by collective bargaining units 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 13, 14 and 55 contribute into the AFSCME Workforce Development Fund. Agencies are charged \$0.15 for each hour that an employee is in an active pay status. Please note that the \$0.15 per hour charge is made up of a combined rate that includes \$.10 per hour paid by the employer and \$0.05 per hour that is paid by the employee via a \$0.05 reduction in the employees hourly step rate of pay. The charge is captured under object of expense 035-19.

Employees represented by collective bargaining unit 40 (CWA), will also have their contributions to the fund cease until further notice.

Per the collective bargaining agreements, no wage scale shall be increased or decreased as a result of the temporary cessation of contributions.
