Update

Welcome to the first edition of the Rhodes Tower Modernization newsletter. This newsletter will be issued at least quarterly to keep tenants and other interested parties up to date on the progress of the project. A website also is being created.

The project will include adding insulation and replacing windows to increase energy efficiency, as well as repairs to the facade.

Ohio Controlling Board approval to release capital appropriations for the first phase of the project was obtained May 22. Turner Construction of Columbus was selected to serve as the construction manager for the project.

Next, Turner will work with the project design team, Schooley Caldwell Associates, to create the final design plan. This design and planning phase is expected to continue through the fall.
