Re: Pay Ranges for College Interns and Student Help

The Office of Talent Management is issuing an update of the hourly rates of pay for college interns and student help. The minimum wage has increased to \$8.30 per hour and is effective January 1, 2018. This is in accordance with the Amendment to Article II, Section 34a of the Ohio Constitution. The following rates will remain in effect until further notice.

Student	Minimum Hourly Rate	Maximum Hourly Rate
High School Co-op/Student Help	State Minimum set pursuant to Article II, Section 34a of the Ohio Constitution.	\$9.40
Undergraduate Student		\$14.72
Graduate Student		\$17.91

Intern/student help rate increases should only be given under two circumstances: 1) where necessary to comply with the minimum wage update and 2) when the intern/student help advances to the next education level (e.g., freshman to sophomore, sophomore to junior, etc.).
