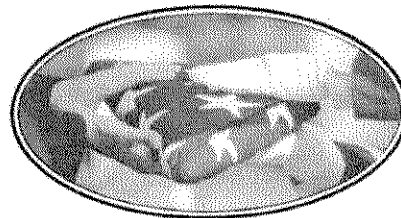

ALL NEW FUNERAL HONORS PERSONNEL ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE 40 HOURS OF TRAINING IN ACCORDANCE WITH NGB STANDARDS. ALL SOLDIERS ARE TRAINED IN THE AREAS OF: COMPREHENSIVE TASKS, CURB TO HEARSE, FLAG FOLD/PRESENT, TRIANGLE FOLDS, TUCK, HAND OFF AND DEPARTURE. IN ADDITION TO THOSE TASKS THEY ARE TRAINED IN UNIFORM MAINTENANCE AND DRILL AND CEREMONIES. SOLDIERS COMPLETING THIS TRAINING ARE AUTHORIZED TO WEAR THE STATE HONOR GUARD TAB AS LONG AS THEY ARE CURRENT MEMBERS OF THE TEAM AND NOT CURRENTLY MOBILIZED.

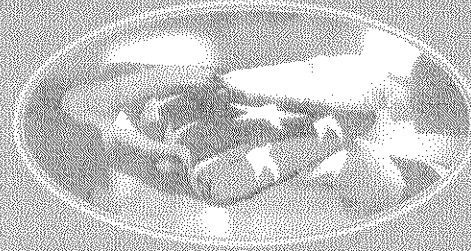

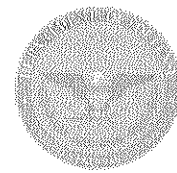
