

AMENDMENT #3 TO SERVICE ATTACHMENT 11 TO THE MASTER SERVICE AGREEMENT
SERVICE ATTACHMENT 11 – AT&T SWITCHED ETHERNET SERVICES

This is an Amendment to the Service Attachment 11 (“Amendment”) to the Master Service Agreement (MSA #0022) – Service Attachment 11 AT&T Switched Ethernet Services between The Department of Administrative Services, on behalf of the State of Ohio (“the State”), and AT&T Corp, on behalf of the AT&T entity authorized to provide Services hereunder: The Ohio Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Ohio (“Vendor” or “AT&T”) (“Contract”).

Customer Name: The Department of Administrative Services, on behalf of the State of Ohio (“the state”), (“Customer”)

Applicable AT&T Affiliate and State: (hereinafter “AT&T”) The Ohio Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Ohio.

WHEREAS, AT&T and the State entered into a Contract last signed by the State on April 10, 2015, as amended, for the provision of AT&T Switched Ethernet Services; and AT&T and the State hereby agree to modify the Contract as follows:

1. VLAN Aggregation Links

AT&T will provide 1Gb/10Gb Ethernet VLAN aggregation links to the following OARnet/State of Ohio POPs to support the VLANs ordered pursuant to this Agreement provided there is a minimum capacity fill rate of 70% per link, per site. One aggregation link per POP will carry a recurring cost of \$1,380 per month and each additional link will be at no charge. In the event OARnet/State of Ohio collocates in another city in Ohio, this same arrangement will apply.

The 10GigE Diverse ASE Collector Circuits at 1320 Arthur E Adams, Columbus OH are to be exclusively used for the purpose of establishing a secondary diverse EVC of equal or less bandwidth to that of an existing primary EVC pointing to a Primary Collector circuit at the same address location. One Diverse link at this site will carry a recurring cost of \$3,820 per month and each additional link will be at no charge.

AT&T reserves the right to restrict any single VLAN as follows:

250Mb on a 1Gb link

1Gb VLAN for INTERLATA connectivity

2Gb VLAN for INTRALATA connectivity



OARNET POP LIST: AKRON, CLEVELAND, DAYTON, TOLEDO, YOUNGSTOWN, SOCC, SOT

This Amendment shall become effective as of the date of State’s signature and shall remain in full force and effect for the term of the Contract. Except as modified by this Amendment, all of the terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

Further, any and all changes made to the attachment after signature by AT&T shall be void and of no effect, unless and until incorporated into a written amendment to this attachment signed by both Parties, except for changes expressly authorized by the terms of this amendment.
