Amendment 1
Wireless as a Service (WaaS)

THIS AMENDMENT NUMBER 1 to Service Attachment 2 (the Amendment) is between the State of Ohio, through its Department of Administrative Services (the 'State'), and RF Works, LLC (the 'Service Provider'). This Amendment changes the terms of the contract issued under Service Attachment 2 dated February 2, 2016 (the 'Service Attachment') and amends Master Cloud Service Agreement, Contract Number MCSA0022 (MCSA).

The Service Attachment is amended as follows:

The Section regarding *Installation* on Page 7 is replaced in its entirety with the language below.

Installation

The wireless service requires low voltage Ethernet cabling, which can be installed by Service Provider, or the Subscribing Entity can install the cable per the RF-Works Design Specification. See Section titled *Optional Service Features* for pricing regarding cabling on Page 2 of Service Attachment 2.

If the Subscribing Entity chooses to have Service Provider execute the cabling all cables, wires, mounts, and connectors will be included. Infrastructure cabling will be run from the switch to the Access Point. The Point of Entry (PoE) for the installation must address Power Over Ethernet available within cabling limitation.

All cabling, wiring, connectors will be installed in a manner that meets the industry safety and security requirements and guidelines. No hazards will be created; any identified hazard will be identified in writing by the Subscribing Entity. Installations must be performed in a manner that does not harm or diminish local site designs or terminate building cable warranties, other buildings warranties, and structural integrity or, to the extent feasible, cosmetics. Installations will meet all prevailing local codes and governing body codes as well as IEEE, TIA/EIA and ISO/IEC Standards for Cabling and Wiring.

Language below regarding Property Moves will be added to the Optional Services Section.

Property Moves. If Subscribing Entity is moving locations, Subscribing Entity must allow RF-Works to conduct a walkthrough of the property and document the condition of the wireless access points prior to vacating. If the Subscribing Entity decides to move the equipment to a new location, RF-Works will charge a one-time fee of \$60 per access point for any equipment that is moved to a new site based on the RF Site Survey. A minimum fee of \$600 will be required per move. If cabling is to be provided by RF-Works, refer to Optional Service Features Section regarding fees.

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Subscribing Entity will be responsible for payment of all fees during the duration of the relocation process as specified in the associated order related to the current location. Once the new location has been surveyed and installed, adjustments will be made to the fees based on the revised access points (new location), starting with the next invoice cycle.

Downtime will be coordinated with the Subscribing Entity's Point of Contact (POC) and a notification will be sent to the State of Ohio Computer Center at CSC@Ohio.gov ten (10) business days prior to the scheduled downtime.
