

CONTRACT AMENDMENT 3 TO MSA0029 BY AND BETWEEN THE STATE OHIO  
DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES  
AND SPRINT SOLUTIONS

The State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, and Sprint Solutions hereby enter into this Amendment this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 2019, with respect to Contract Number MSA0029 ("Agreement"), subject to the terms and conditions thereof. This Amendment becomes a part of the Agreement as if written fully below. Any terms and conditions of the Agreement not modified or changed by this Amendment will remain in full force and effect.

WHEREAS, the State and the Contractor determined that a Contract Amendment is necessary to address certain revisions to the Contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Contract is amended as follows:

**Section 15.1 MODIFICATIONS 3. Section 6 Term.** The Agreement is amended by deleting Section 15.1 ("Modifications"), Subsection 3 "Section 6 Term" in its entirety.

**Agreement Renewal.** In accordance with Section 6.1 ("Agreement – Renewal"), the State renews the Agreement and all Service Attachments in the next biennium, effective July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2021.

The following provision is added as a new provision:

**Boycotting.** Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 9.76 (B) Contractor warrants that Contractor is not boycotting any jurisdiction with whom the State of Ohio can enjoy open trade, including Israel, and will not do so during the contract period.

The following Location of Data provision replaces the existing Governing the Expenditure of Public Funds on Offshore Services provision:

**Prohibition of the Expenditure of Public Funds for Offshore Services.** No State Cabinet, Agency, Board or Commission will enter into any contract to purchase services provided outside the United States or that allows State data to be sent, taken, accessed, tested, maintained, backed-up, stored, or made available remotely outside (located) of the United States. Notwithstanding any other terms of this Contract, the State reserves the right to recover any funds paid for services the Contractor performs outside of the United States for which it did not receive a waiver. The State does not waive any other rights and remedies provided the State in the Contract.

The Contractor must complete the Contractor/Subcontractor Affirmation and Disclosure form affirming the Contractor understands and will meet the requirements of the above prohibition. During the performance of this Contract, the Contractor must not change the location(s) disclosed on the Affirmation and Disclosure Form, unless a duly signed waiver from the State has been attained to perform the services outside the United States.

The Parties agree that the Executive Order provisions do not apply to services that are incidental to the total cost of the Service purchased. Services are incidental when the value of those incidental services is substantially less than the price of the Service purchased or the incidental services are not a substantial part of the work. Since the Services were specifically designed and are being marketed primarily for use in the United States and its territories, the

Parties agree that any use of the Services outside of the U.S. and its territories is incidental to the Services and therefore Contractor has been granted a waiver of this requirement and can affirm all contents of the Contractor/Subcontractor Affirmation and Disclosure form indicated above.

The following provision is added as a new provision:






